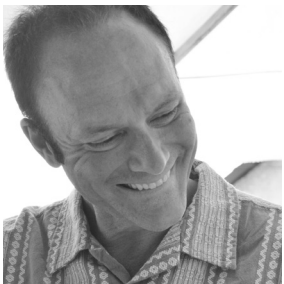

Partridge Boswell's first book of poems *Some Far Country* was selected by Ifeanyi Menkiti for the Grolier Discovery Award. His poems appear in the Saguaro Poetry Prize-winning chapbook *Not Yet a Jedi* and in *Poetry*, *Gettysburg Review*, *Salmagundi*,

American Poetry Review, *Poetry Ireland Review*, *Prairie Schooner*, *The Moth*, &c. Co-founder of Bookstock Literary Festival, he teaches at Vallum Society for Education in Arts & Letters in Montreal, and troubadours widely with the poetry/music group Los Lorcas, whose debut release *Last Night in America* is available on Thunder Ridge Records (loslorcas.com). He lives with his family in Vermont.



Shanta Lee is an award winning artist who works in different mediums as a photographer, writer across genres, and a public intellectual. She is the author of the poetry collection, *GHETTOCLAUSTROPHOBIA: Dreamin of Mama While Trying to*

Speak Woman in Woke Tongues (Diode, 2021) and illustrated collection, *Black Metamorphoses* (Etruscan Press, 2023). *Dark Goddess: An Exploration of the Sacred Feminine*, her latest exhibition, is on view at the Fleming Museum of Art. Learn more at shantalee.com.

He served as poet laureate of Vermont from 2015 to 2019. He lives in Westminster West, Vermont with his wife, Liz.
